

Sparkling Wines

Prosecco, Valdo; Treviso Italy, NV [187ml - 1/4 btl]
Delicate, flowery nose with pear and apple aromas.

Prosecco, Dolci Colline; Treviso Italy, NV
Citrus, pear, apple, honey, lively on the palate, zesty acidity and a clean, refreshing finish.

Sparkling Wine, Valdo; Numero 1, Italy, NV
The best inexpensive bubbly we've come across in a while. Light straw color, fruity aromas, nice sweetness while being extra dry.

Mirabelle Brut, Schramsberg; CA, NV
Buttered toast, citrus, floral, nuts & cream. Wonderfully complex. Traditional method used in Champagne and some of the best bubbly made in the US.

Rosé Wines

Rosé, Underwood; OR 2018
Pinot noir & grenache. Fruit forward nose with soft strawberry, apricot and ruby grapefruit notes.

Rosé, Domaine La Fage; Roussillon, France '16
Old vine Mourvèdre, Grenache and Grenache. Medium bodied, fruity, dry and very balanced. A delicious value.

White Wines

Pinot Grigio, Riff, Alois Lageder; Italy 2017
Good structure and intensity on the palate, balanced with lively acidity. Light and easy to drink; pairs well with salads.

Sauvignon Blanc, Arona; New Zealand 2018
Zesty ripe passion fruit and melon, fresh texture and subtle hint of grassiness. Everything a sauvignon blanc should be; pairs well with shellfish and white fish.

Riesling, Gryphon Crest; Germany 2017/2018
Pineapple, guava, nectarine, nice minerality and fresh finish of honey and spice. Just sweet enough to satisfy everyone; pairs well with spicy foods.

Pinot Gris, Owen Roe; WA 2018
Aromas of green apple and honey suckle give way to a bone dry finish with notes of crab apple and lemon.



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White Wines Continued



Chardonnay, Fable; CA 2017
Pastry and toasted biscuit nose with mouthwatering acidity and slight new French oak; pairs well with creamy foods & chicken

Chardonnay, Domaine Eden; CA 2010
Excellent flintiness with sweet oak, apple and citrus with a wonderful long finish. Rare vintage and a gem on the menu, only a few bottles left.

Chardonnay, Ferrari Carano; CA 2017
Aromas of pear, white peach, graham cracker and vanilla lead to vibrant and refreshing flavors of apple, cinnamon and Meyer lemon.

Chardonnay, Cyprus CA 2017
Lovely straw hue with a bright apple, lemon-lime citrus nose with a floral quality tasting note with limestone minerality and subtle peach.

Pouilly-Fuisse, Domaine Cheveau; France 2015
This elegant Chardonnay offers notes of hazelnuts, ripe apples and lemon. This is a wonderful example of Pouilly-Fuisse from an outstanding producer.

Chablis, Droin; France 2016
An absolute stunner and value when it comes to A.O.C. Chablis. Still quite young, let this chardonnay breathe a bit before you drink it to allow its texture and flavors to truly shine!

Sancerre, Lucien Crochet; France 2017
Delicious combination of lime, pineapple and honeydew mingled with chalk and salt. Fruit and mineral perfectly balanced. A memorable and complex Sauvignon Blanc.

White Bordeaux, Chateau Briot; France 2016
Pale yellow with greenish tints. Aromas of citrus, peach and honey give way to a well-rounded, supple and fruity tasting notes with a lasting finish.

Red Wines

Zinfandel, Foxglove; CA 2016
Rich dark fruit, mocha, spices and a huge, exuberant personality. A floral, unoaked Zinfandel with distinct Pinot-inflected overtones. Delicious!

Beaujolais Cuvee, Domaine de la Prebende; France 2018
Deeply mineral nose and palate with classic Beaujolais structure, fermented for 14 days and bottled unfiltered.

Bordeaux, Château Lanessan; France 2002
Silky and voluptuous. Flavors of cherry and currant. Well balanced soft acidity and earthiness.

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Red Wines Continued

Cab Sauvignon, Avalon; CA 2017

Fruity, fresh, easy to enjoy. Lush, yet dry. Smoothness of barrel age but little overt oak flavor. Juicy berry with just enough bite.

Cab Sauvignon, Barnard Griffin; WA 2017

Exuberant dark fruit and toasty spice notes. Fresh, focused flavors. Hints of cinnamon, cooking spice and orange add depth and dimension.

Cab Sauvignon, Starmont; CA 2016

Dark red in color, with purple and black hues. Aromas of bright fruit flavors along with subtle toasty oak are framed by well-balanced acidity and well resolved tannins.

Cab Sauvignon, Domaine Eden; CA 2014

Plum, black pepper, char, leather and dried herb aromas. Charred fruit, pine resin and caramel flavors. Satisfying and full of umami characteristics.

Red Blend, The Boatman; CA 2017

46% Alicante Bouschet & 54% Malbec. Deep purple in color with a fragrant blackberry, rhubarb, and crushed peppercorn. The palate is sultry and voluptuous with a broad mouthfeel with black cherries, violet taste with a long elegant finish.

Red Blend, Fiction; CA 2016

Interesting Zinfandel blend Aged in a combination of new French and American oak. Fruity yet complex with spicy accents and great depth of flavor. It's generous and approachable.

Red Blend, Massaya; Beirut, Lebanon 2016

35% Black Grenache, 35% Cinsault and 30% Tempranillo. A fresh, thirst-quenching wine with notes of spice and pepper with a fruit forward finish.

Languedoc Rouge, H&B; France 2017

Carignan, Grenache & Syrah. A beautiful carmine red color reveals aromas of red fruit and then, spicy and peppery shades.

Merlot, The Path; CA 2016

Juicy on the palate with flavors of Bing cherry, blackberry, and notes of crushed herb underpinned by the spice from French Oak the wine sees during aging.

Merlot, Kiona; WA 2016

100% Red Mountain merlot, chewy and tannic, with black cherry, cassis and a hint of dark chocolate. A fantastic steak wine. Not your typical 80's merlot.

Cotes du Rhone, Andezon; France 2016

Fruit and earth find a nice balance in this medium-bodied, fruity, soft wine with excellent purity and noticeable tannins.



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Red Wines Continued



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Pinot Noir, Rickshaw; CA 2017

Light medium body with red fruit dominated flavors with hints of plum, cola, cinnamon and forest floor. A value from the boys at Banshee.

Pinot Noir, Stafford Hill; OR 2017

An excellent Oregon example of a traditional unfiltered Burgundian style pinot. Sweet cherry and forest underbrush, with food-friendly acidity and a floral finish.

Malbec Classico, Altos Las Hormigas; ARG 2017

Bright ruby red color. Supple tannins and balanced acidity. Notes of crisp red fruits with a soft texture and a long finish. 100% Mendoza Malbec grapes. Pairs with various dishes from red meats to pasta or grilled vegetables.

Rioja, Rio Madre; Spain 2017

100% graciano. Black pepper, dark fruit, mouth watering and lip smacking, Matured in French oak. A terrific full bodied red!

Rioja, Rivarey; Spain 2015

100% Tempranillo. Aromas of vanilla with a remarkable palate of red fruits with a silky mouthfeel. Aged in French oak.

Barolo, Damilano; Italy 2013

100% Nebbiolo, deep ruby red with slight orange hues and an intense aroma of vanilla and licorice. Dry and full-bodied with a warm and elegant texture. An Italian classic for a reason.

Nebbiolo, Rizzi; Italy 2016

Deep garnet red in color. The nose reveals sensual components of violet and rose with a crisp red fruit, black pepper, clove and licorice. Mouthfeel is full and mellow, very balanced with a great tanic structure.

Barbera D'Asti, Deforville; Italy 2017

85% Barbera. The nose is fruit forward with spicy and toasted aromas. Flavor is full and round, juicy in attack with a balanced acidity and low tannins.

Chianti Classico, Basilica Caffaggio; Italy 2015

100% Sangiovese. Fragrant wild berry, blue flowers, new leather take center stage leading to dried cherry, star anise and crushed herbs.

Bourgogne Rouge, Thevenet & Fils; France 2017

A wonderful French Burgandy pinot noir. Fruity and earthy on the nose. Chewy and sappy on the palate. Balancing acidity give way to a long, savory finish.

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
